

## I spy!

This is a fun game that encourages children to notice things around their home or outside.



### What you need:

- Cardboard tubes
- Cellotape or glue
- String
- Anything to decorate it

### What to do:

Help your child stick two tubes together and attach some string so they can wear the binoculars around their neck. Make a pair for yourself too! You can do this in the house, looking out of the window or standing at the door. Look through the binoculars and choose an object but don't tell your child what it is. Give them a hint... I spy something that begins with, I spy something that is red, I spy something that is fluffy, I spy something that moves.

### Questions to ask.....

- Is it outside?
- Does it make a noise?
- Can I hold it?

**Use the binoculars and play 'I spy' when you read your child's favourite book together.**
