



What you need:

- Pans and pan lids
- A potato masher, whisks or other metal kitchen utensils
- Wooden bowls and spoons
- Cups and spoons

What to do:

Ask your child to explore making different sounds with equipment e.g. rubbing objects together or tapping them. Turn some pans upside down and encourage your child to make different sounds on them. Try using two saucepan lids as cymbals! Experiment with different utensils on the same pan. Make a microphone from a cardboard tube and sing along!

Questions to ask.....

- What sound does it make?
- Can you make a loud sound?
- Can you tap out your name?
